Joint Flight Training Scholarship

EAA Chapter #631 and Island City Aero Club

Both EAA Chapter #631 and Island City Aero Club are organized to support aviation by awarding a \$2,000 scholarship (\$1,000 from each club) to a flight student seeking a private pilots license or additional advanced training. Applicants must reside within Barron, Bayfield, Chippewa, Polk, Rusk, Sawyer, or Washburn County and must be at least 16 years of age. Applications are due by March 1 each year.

Applicants must complete (at their expense) several criteria including:

- 1) FAA "Student Pilots License"
- 2) FAA Class 3 (or other) Medical License
- 3) An introductory flight lesson with a Certified Flight Instructor
- 4) A letter of recommendation from a Certified Flight Instructor
- 5) An essay (less than 1,000 words) about your aviation goals
- 6) A listing of your aviation experience

Note: Several of the criteria involve communication with the FAA and additional information may be obtained by contacting representatives from either aviation club.

Applications will be reviewed by a joint committee from both clubs. A successful applicant will be provided with a "letter of agreement" to reimburse the student for \$2,000 of training expenses upon completion of the aviation goal. A mentor will be provided to the student for support and to answer questions about the program as the training proceeds. Any Certified Flight Instructor may be used and training must be completed within two years.
